- School Reports from the previous two semesters
- Most recent NAPLAN results
- Must complete the Urangan SHS ACE Academic exam
- Reference from Primary School Administration Member
- Evidence of academic achievement to support application. e.g. certificates from external competitions
- Other evidence to support this application; certificates that demonstrate you have been a positive role model to your school and peers. These may include leadership roles such as school and house captains, captains of teams, leadership positions within your classroom and participation in school and community activities (Fundraising activities, Clean up Australia Day, charity work etc.)

Music Scholarship – Creative Thinkers Information Required:

- You have auditioned for the ACE Music Program
- Evidence of Musical achievement to support this application. e.g. certificates and information showing your involvement in the Creative Arts including music, choir and instrumental programs both within the school or the local community.
- Reference from Primary School Administration Member

Cultural Scholarship – Connected Humans Information Required:

- School Reports from the previous two semesters
- Evidence in involvement in the School Community that demonstrates you have been a positive role model to your school and your peers. Eg: Leadership positions at school. Community service participation. Involvement in Creative Arts such as Dance, Performing Arts, Visual Art or representing the school through sporting achievements or awards.
- Reference from Primary School Administration Member
