

WHY BECOME A USHS ULEAD STUDENT?

When you become a U-Lead member, you can:

- access to leadership training and skill development
- receive rewards and recognition
- participate in and lead school and community events
- obtain references for future employment and training
- build a new network of friends
- make a real difference to your school through your actions and ideas
- represent your peers in decision making
- develop links between the school and community
- learn skills related to fundraising and events organisation
- contribute to building a positive school culture

ULEAD GENERAL MEMBERSHIP PROCESS

How do I nominate?

There are two methods for student nomination into the U-Lead program at Urangan State High School:

1. SELF NOMINATION	2. TEACHER NOMINATION
Students nominate themselves by completing a U-Lead Membership application form (Appendix 1).	<u>Teachers nominate a student</u> based on observed behaviours and qualities that indicate membership into the U-Lead program.
This form is available at Students Services.	The teacher can give the student a U-Lead Membership application form (Appendix 1) directly or refer the student to Students Services to collect.

When can I nominate?

Students can nominate themselves <u>at any time</u>, as can teachers. However, students must have been enrolled at Urangan SHS for a minimum of one Semester. The application form should be completed and submitted to Student Services. The application will be processed further by relevant staff.

Who assesses the U-Lead General Membership applications?

The Head of Department for Student Leadership, and the Student Leadership Coordinator in consultation with other staff members will shortlist applicants. Final approval will be made by the relevant Head of Year. The Principal will make the final decision about the application.

When will I find out if I am successful?

Applications are reviewed at least once per term. New members generally commence in ULead activities from the start of the following school term. U-Lead badges are awarded at the Leaders Induction Ceremony which is held annually. Successful applicants and their parent/ care giver will be informed via email and then be acknowledged at an assembly with a certificate of recognition. The final step for membership is to sign the Student Leadership Agreement.

What if I am unsuccessful?

You will be given feedback from your Head of Year regarding the specific areas of improvement required. You will be invited to apply again at a later date. There are no limits to the number of times you can apply.

^{*}When you have been a ULead member for at least one term, you are eligible to apply to fill specific leadership roles.
