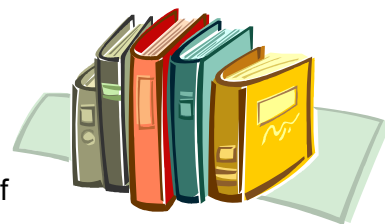




YEAR 7 CLASS ORGANISATION INFORMATION



Students will be divided into classes based on information provided by their primary school. These class groups will contain students with a variety of abilities and from a variety of primary schools.

The focus of the first semester is to settle students into Year 7. Their experience at school should reflect the elements of primary school that they are familiar with, overlaid with the new experiences of high school life. The clear emphasis is then:

- ✓ Getting to know students in their classes
- ✓ Orientating students to the nature of high school work
- ✓ Setting and reinforcing clear expectations and standards
- ✓ Preparing them for their junior years at secondary school

Students with Learning Difficulties

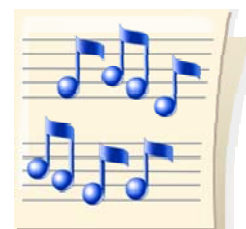
Students who have learning difficulties will receive assistance through programs organised by our Head of Department – Learning Improvement.
